Arbor App-

This is now live, and thank you to the 82% of parents who have logged in. Please ring reception if you are having trouble with your account or logging in, as moving forward the school will need everyone to have access to this app, for communication, meal ordering, booking trips, and payments. Parent Pay is now closed. All accounts in credit and owing have now been transferred over to their child's new Arbor account.

If you would like to book Breakfast Club prior to the day, you can now book daily, weekly, or termly and pay upfront. This enables the teachers to gain a register prior to the day, which supports us with our breakfast numbers. Children will continue to book meals within class with their teachers.



Parent's Evening-

Luke 6:17, 20-26

Summary: Jesus blesses the poor, hungry, and sorrowful, promising them future joy and rewards in heaven. He warns the rich, well-fed, and joyful of future sorrow, highlighting how ancestors treated true and false prophets.

Gospel Acclamation: Rejoice and be glad; your reward will be great in heaven. (Luke 6:23)

Jesus came down with the twelve and stood on a stretch of level ground with a great crowd of his disciples and a large number of the people from all Judea and Jerusalem and the coastal region of Tyre and Sidon.

And raising his eyes toward his disciples he said:

“Blessed are you who are poor, for the kingdom of God is yours.

Blessed are you who are now hungry, for you will be satisfied.

Blessed are you who are now weeping, for you will laugh.
