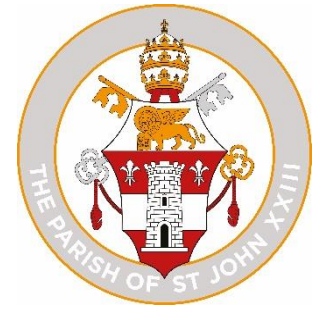

Mount Snowden Charity Climb

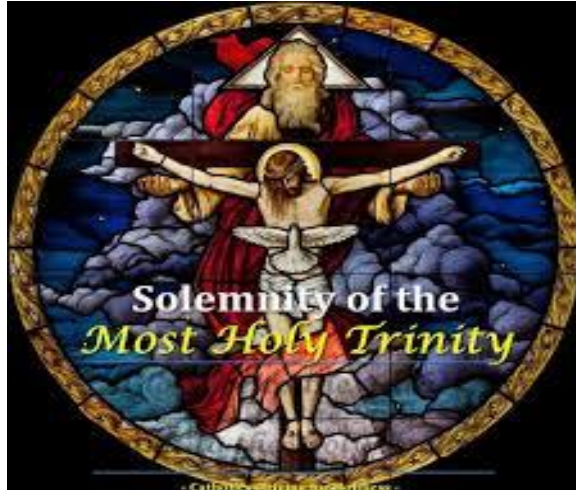
