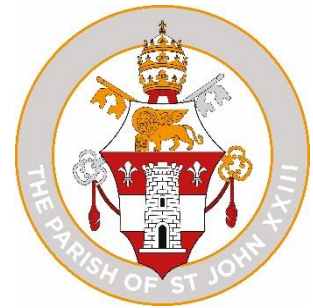

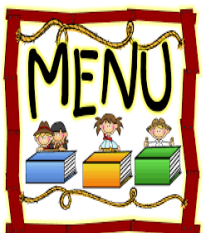

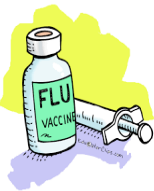


School Admissions for September 2022

This show has a large cast of nearly a hundred children and adults and includes some of our teachers and pupils.

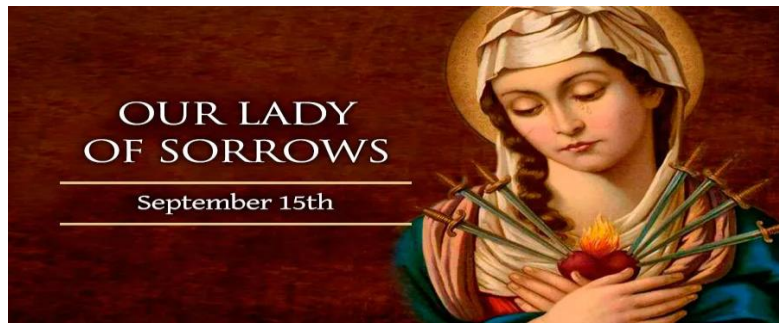
Kidz4Kidz shows are not-for-profit, with all proceeds going to a local child in need or children's charity. They have won numerous awards over the years.

**This Sunday, 12th September 2021, is the Twenty Fourth Sunday
in Ordinary Time**

In this week's Gospel we hear that it is not always easy to follow Jesus. Sometimes it requires courage.

Gospel: Mark 8:27-35

Then Jesus and his disciples went away to the villages near Caesarea Philippi. On the way he asked them, "Tell me, who do people say I am?"

"Some say that you are John the Baptist," they answered; "others say that you are Elijah, while others say that you are one of the prophets."

"What about you?" he asked them. "Who do you say I am?" Peter answered, "You are the Messiah." Then Jesus ordered them, "Do not tell anyone about me."

Then Jesus began to teach his disciples: "The Son of Man must suffer much and be rejected by the elders, the chief priests, and the teachers of the Law. He will be put to death, but three days later he will rise to life." He made this very clear to them. So Peter took him aside and began to rebuke him. But Jesus turned around, looked at his disciples, and rebuked Peter. "Get away from me, Satan," he said. "Your thoughts don't come from God but from human nature!" Then Jesus called the crowd and his disciples to him. "If any of you want to come with me," he told them, "you must forget yourself, carry your cross, and follow me. For if you want to save your own life, you will lose it; but if you lose your life for me and for the gospel, you will save it.
