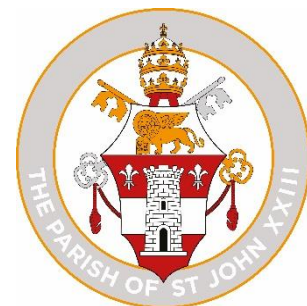

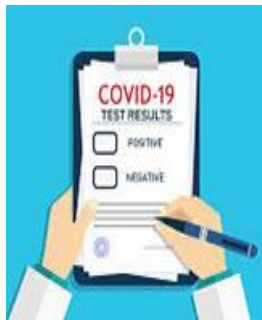


**School Admissions for September 2022 – DEADLINE SATURDAY, 15<sup>th</sup> JAN 2022**

School admissions are now open for children who are due to start primary school in September 2022.

### Changes to the self-isolation period for those who test positive for COVID-19

From Monday, 17<sup>th</sup> January 2022, pupils who are self-isolating with COVID-19 have the option to reduce their isolation period after 5 full days if they test negative with a lateral flow device (LFD) test on both day 5 and day 6 and they do not have a temperature. For example, if they test negative on the morning of day 5 and the morning of day 6, they can return to school on day 6. Please note that the first day of symptoms or the day your child has a positive LFD test result if they don't have any symptoms, is classed as day 0.

The first test must be taken no earlier than day 5 of the self-isolation period, and the second must be taken the following day.

If the result of either of their tests is positive, they should continue to self-isolate until they get negative results from two LFD tests on consecutive days or until they have completed 10 full days of self-isolation, whichever is earliest.

Anyone who is unable to take LFD tests or anyone who continues to have a temperature will need to complete the full 10 day period of self-isolation.

# Wedding Feast at Cana



## Sunday, 16<sup>th</sup> January 2022, is the Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

This Sunday's Gospel is the start of Jesus' ministry and his first miracle. We hear that Jesus, his mother Mary and his disciples attended a wedding feast in Cana, Galilee where he changed water into wine.

### Gospel: John 2: 1-11

Two days later there was a wedding in the town of Cana in Galilee. Jesus' mother was there. Jesus and his followers were also invited to the wedding. When all the wine was gone, Jesus' mother said to him, "They have no more wine."

Jesus answered, "Dear woman, why come to me? My time has not yet come."

His mother said to the servants, "Do whatever he tells you to do."

In that place there were six stone water jars. The Jews used jars like these in their washing ceremony. Each jar held about 20 or 30 gallons.

Jesus said to the servants, "Fill the jars with water." So they filled the jars to the top.

Then he said to them, "Now take some out and give it to the master of the feast."

So the servants took the water to the master. When he tasted it, the water had become wine. He did not know where the wine came from. But the servants who brought the water knew. The master of the wedding called the bridegroom and said to him, "People always serve the best wine first. Later, after the guests have been drinking a lot, they serve the cheaper wine. But you have saved the best wine till now."

So in Cana of Galilee, Jesus did his first miracle. There he showed his glory, and his followers believed in him.
