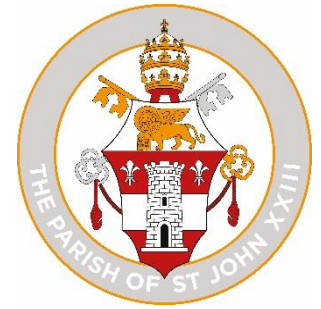

Mrs Dowson – Intervention Teacher (previously Year 4/5 Teacher)

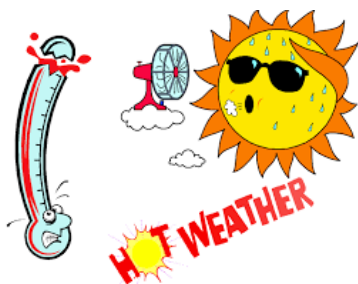
Mrs Ingham – Year 5/6 Teaching Assistant

School meals

We are having new ovens fitted over the summer holidays and our full school meal menu will resume in September.

Please see Dojo for our meal menus each week. If your child would like to have an 'ad hoc' meal all they need to do is let their Teacher know on the day – no pre-ordering is required.

Please note that the cost of a school meal is increasing to £2.40 per day from September

Children moving into Year 3 in September 2022 will no longer be eligible for Universal Free School Meals. If you would like your child to continue having a school meal this will be chargeable at £2.40 per day (payable via ParentPay). For children who are registered for Free School Meals there will be no charge.

Sunday, 17th July 2022, Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time



In this Sunday's Gospel Jesus visits the house of Martha and Mary and we see how Mary is an example of how a disciple should listen.

Gospel: Luke 10: 38-42

While Jesus and his followers were traveling, Jesus went into a town. A woman named Martha let Jesus stay at her house. Martha had a sister named Mary. Mary was sitting at Jesus' feet and listening to him teach. Martha became angry because she had so much work to do. She went in and said, "Lord, don't you care that my sister has left me alone to do all the work? Tell her to help me!"

But the Lord answered her, "Martha, Martha, you are getting worried and upset about too many things. Only one thing is important. Mary has chosen the right thing, and it will never be taken away from her."
