### MESSAGE FROM THE HEADTEACHER

Dear Parents/Carers

I am sure you are aware that the current situation we are in with regards to Coronavirus is not improving and it is anticipated that Lancashire will be going into tighter lockdown measures soon. I have noticed that more and more children are absent from school with cold and flu like symptoms and are isolating whilst awaiting a COVID test; I am also aware of the frustrations you have in booking one. I thank God that we have not had any positive cases in school to date.

All our staff members share your concerns about the need to ensure your child's education is not impacted majorly by absences caused by isolating so we have put measures in place to help:

- If your child is self-isolating due to their own, or a family member's symptoms/positive test, a pack of work will be provided for them (which you will need to collect from school) or the class teacher will provide work via Dojo or email that the rest of the class are doing in school
- If your child's class bubble has to isolate for 14 days they will be provided with a work pack. In addition, teachers (unless they are ill) have agreed to do daily Maths and English lessons (and phonics in the Infants) over video or Zoom with activities for the children to complete at home. The teachers will also set additional daily online activities via platforms such as Dojo Portfolio, Purple Mash, Serial Mash, TT Rockstars and Numbots

As a lot of the planned work will need to be done online please ensure that you have access to the internet at home and a suitable device for your child to use. If you do not have this please let your child's teacher know.

Also, please check that you still have all the access details needed for the online resources such as Purple Mash, TT Rockstars and Numbots etc. If not please let their teacher know.

In addition, register on Dojo Portfolios (the teachers will have let you know about this) and let your child's teacher have up-to-date email addresses so that work can be emailed to you if necessary.
