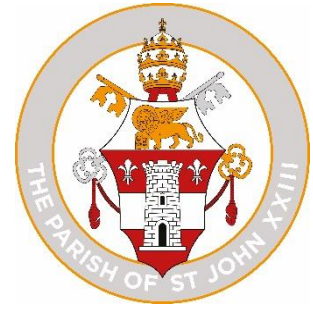

COVID-19

Unfortunately one of our Junior pupils tested positive for COVID-19 earlier this week. If your child has any of the standard COVID-19 symptoms or what you think is simply a cold or flu please keep them at home and carry out a home Lateral Flow Test or book a COVID (PCR) test. To protect our school community your child can only return once the test has been carried out with a negative result. Lateral Flow Test results are available in 30 minutes.

Lateral Flow Test kits are available to all households who have school aged children and can be collected from hubs based on UCLAN car park and Walton-Le-Dale Park and Ride. The sites are open Monday-Sunday from 1.30pm - 7.00pm and no appointment is needed. You can collect 2 packs x 7 tests which any member of your family can use. We strongly recommend that all families obtain and use the tests.

Alternatively, via the link below, you can order 1 pack x 7 tests for home delivery and these should arrive within 2 days.
