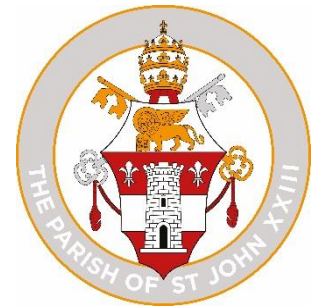

### REMINDER - School start time

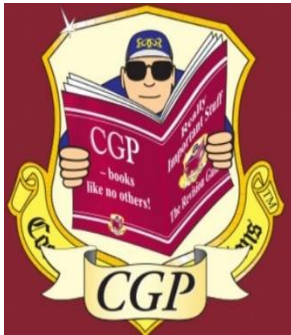
Please remember that school is open from 8:45am and lessons start at 8:55am – late arrivals disrupt the class lesson and your child's learning.

# November is the month of the Holy Souls



## This Sunday, 21<sup>st</sup> November 2021, is the Feast of Christ the King

In this Sunday's Gospel Pilate asks Jesus if he is king of the Jews. Jesus answers that His kingdom is no earthly kingdom.

**Gospel:** John 18:33-37

"Then Pilate went back inside the palace. He called Jesus to him and asked, "Are you the king of the Jews?"

Jesus said, "Is that your own question, or did others tell you about me?"

Pilate answered, "I am not a Jew. It was your own people and their leading priests who brought you before me. What have you done wrong?"

Jesus said, "My kingdom does not belong to this world. If it belonged to this world, my servants would have fought to keep me from being given over to the Jewish leaders. But my kingdom is from another place."

Pilate said, "So you are a king!"

Jesus answered, "You say that I am a king. That is true. I was born for this: to tell people about the truth. That is why I came into the world. And everyone who belongs to the truth listens to me."
