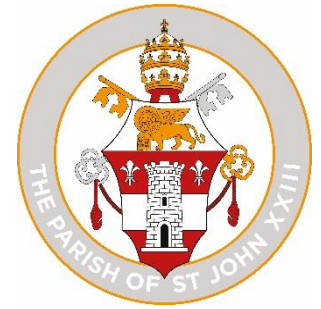

Sunday, 3rd July 2022, Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

In this Sunday's Gospel Jesus appoints 72 people to go ahead of him to every town and place he plans to visit, proclaiming that the Kingdom of God is at hand. He sends them in pairs; in the Law of Moses two witnesses were needed for a testimony to be credible and it was probably also a safer way to travel.

A key theme of this Sunday's and last Sunday's Gospel is discipleship—its challenges, its difficulties, and its rewards. Sharing in the mission of Jesus is difficult, but everyone is called to do it.

Gospel: Luke 10:1-12, 17-20

After this, the Lord chose 72 others. He sent them out in pairs. He sent them ahead of him into every town and place where he planned to go. He said to them, "There are a great many people to harvest. But there are only a few workers to harvest them. God owns the harvest. Pray to God that he will send more workers to help gather his harvest. You can go now. But listen! I am sending you, and you will be like sheep among wolves. Don't carry a purse, a bag, or sandals. Don't stop to talk with people on the road. Before you go into a house, say, 'Peace be with this house.' If a peaceful man lives there, your blessing of peace will stay with him. If the man is not peaceful, then your blessing of peace will come back to you. Stay in the same house. Eat and drink what the people there give you. A worker should be given his pay. Don't move from house to house. If you go into a town and the people welcome you, eat what they give you. Heal the sick who live there. Tell them, 'The kingdom of God is soon coming to you!' But if you go into a town, and the people don't welcome you, then go out into the streets of that town. Say to them, 'Even the dirt from your town that sticks to our feet we wipe off against you. But remember that the kingdom of God is coming soon.' I tell you, on the Judgment Day it will be worse for the people of that town than for the people of Sodom.

When the 72 men came back from their trip, they were very happy. They said, "Lord, even the demons obeyed us when we used your name!"

Jesus said to the men, "I saw Satan falling like lightning from the sky. Listen! I gave you power to walk on snakes and scorpions. I gave you more power than the Enemy has. Nothing will hurt you. You should be happy, but not because the spirits obey you. You should be happy because your names are written in heaven."
