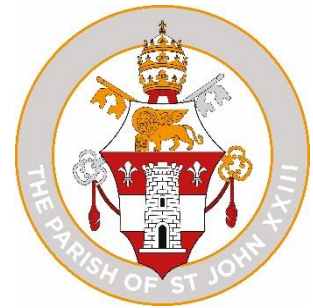

# The month of October is dedicated to the Most Holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary



## This Sunday, 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2021, is the Twenty Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

In this Sunday's Gospel we hear that Jesus' disciples tried to stop people bringing their children to him for his blessing. When Jesus notices this he tells them to let the children come to him. Jesus welcomed and blessed the children and says that the kingdom of God belongs to children.

### **Gospel:** Mark 10:2-16 (extract)

Some people brought children to Jesus for him to place his hands on them, but the disciples scolded the people. When Jesus noticed this, he was angry and said to his disciples, "Let the children come to me, and do not stop them, because the Kingdom of God belongs to such as these. I assure you that whoever does not receive the Kingdom of God like a child will never enter it." Then he took the children in his arms, placed his hands on each of them, and blessed them.
