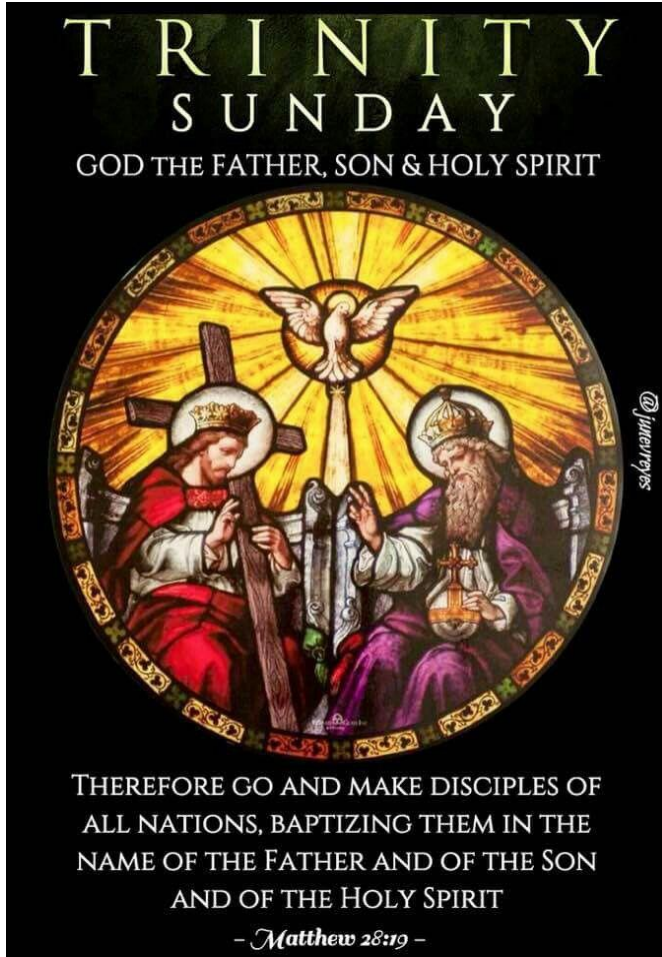
Teacher training (PGCE with QTS) is available in all phases:
