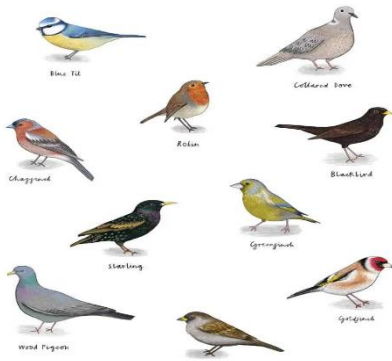

Big Garden Birdwatch Weekend – 26th – 28th January 2024

The Big Garden Birdwatch survey is taking place this weekend. This is the UK's biggest citizen science wildlife survey and is a great opportunity for your child to get involved watching the birds in your area.



School uniform

We have noticed that there has been a decline in the standard of uniform being worn by a number of our pupils.

Please remember that our winter uniform is:-

Red Jumper/ Cardigan

Grey skirt or pinafore dress with grey tights or grey/ white socks

Grey trousers with grey/ black socks

White shirt/Polo shirt

Sensible black school shoes

Trainers must be all black – coloured trainers including black trainers with some colour are not allowed

Trainers (black only with no colour or logos) and PE kit must only be worn on PE days



Earrings & Jewellery

Pupils may wear earrings but they must be the small stud type – no hoops or other fashion earrings are allowed.

On the day that your child has PE / games lessons (including After School Clubs) all jewellery including earrings must be removed or covered by a plaster. This has to be done at home or by the child as staff members cannot remove/cover earrings.

Please note that no other forms of jewellery are allowed eg necklaces and rings

This Sunday, 28th January 2024, is the Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time



In this week's Gospel we hear how Jesus starts to teach in the temple.

Gospel: Mark 1: 21-28

Jesus and his followers went to Capernaum. On the Sabbath day Jesus went to the synagogue and began to teach. The people there were amazed at his teaching. He did not teach like their teachers of the law. He taught like a person who had authority. While he was in the synagogue, a man was there who had an evil spirit in him. The man shouted, "Jesus of Nazareth! What do you want with us? Did you come to destroy us? I know who you are—God's Holy One!"

Jesus said strongly, "Be quiet! Come out of the man!" The evil spirit made the man shake violently. Then the spirit gave a loud cry and came out of him.

The people were amazed. They asked each other, "What is happening here? This man is teaching something new. And he teaches with authority. He even gives commands to evil spirits, and they obey him." And the news about Jesus spread quickly everywhere in the area of Galilee.
