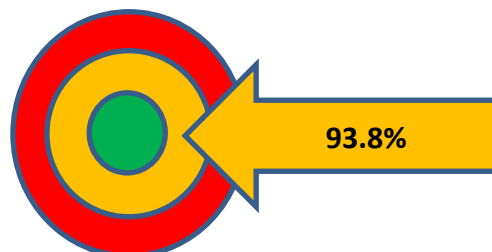

School Meal Menu

You may have noticed the slight change of format to our school meal menu from next week.

From Monday, 19th June 2023, we will be using a new system for ordering/recording meal choices in school and the pupils will now be selecting 'colour' options (red, blue, green, yellow) when making their meal choices in class each day.

Each option on the menu will state (M) or (V) to indicate meat or vegetarian.



St Augustine's Summer Holiday Club- Free to our Pupils!

Non Uniform Days

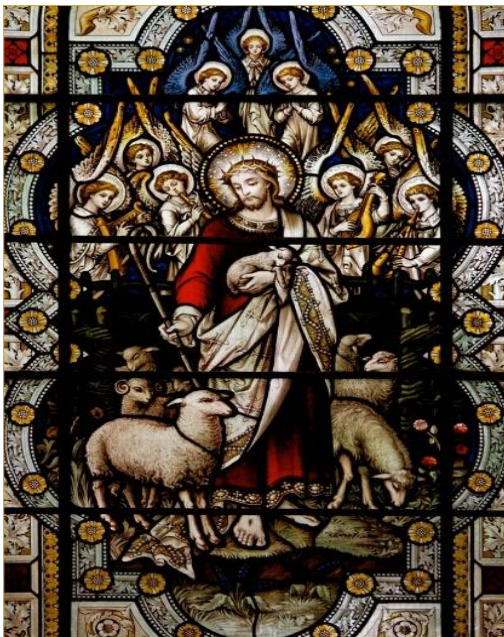
We will be holding two non-uniform days ahead of our Summer Fair as follows:

Friday, 30th June 2023 - We ask children to donate £1.00 (cash)

Friday, 7th July 2023 - KS1 children to bring chocolate items (bars, biscuits, multipacks etc.)

KS2 children to bring drinks such as coke, lemonade, limeade, cherryade, flavoured water etc. (plastic bottles only please)

This Sunday, 18th June 2023 is the Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time



This week we learn about how Jesus was moved with compassion for people who were worried and looking for help. He sent the disciples out to care for them and he asks us to carry on this work today.

Gospel: Matthew 9: 36 – 10:8

As he saw the crowds, his heart was filled with pity for them, because they were worried and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd. So he said to his disciples, “The harvest is large, but there are few workers to gather it in. Pray to the owner of the harvest that he will send out workers to gather in his harvest.”

Jesus called his twelve disciples together and gave them authority to drive out evil spirits and to heal every disease and every sickness. These are the names of the twelve apostles: first, Simon (called Peter) and his brother Andrew; James and his brother John, the sons of Zebedee; Philip and Bartholomew; Thomas and Matthew, the tax collector; James son of Alphaeus, and Thaddaeus; Simon the Patriot, and Judas Iscariot, who betrayed Jesus.

These twelve men were sent out by Jesus with the following instructions: “Do not go to any Gentile territory or any Samaritan towns. Instead, you are to go to the lost sheep of the people of Israel. Go and preach, ‘The Kingdom of heaven is near!’ Heal the sick, bring the dead back to life, heal those who suffer from dreaded skin diseases, and drive out demons. You have received without paying, so give without being paid.
