# ALLHALLOWTIDE



The three days of All Hallows' Eve, All Hallows' Day, and All Souls' Day are collectively referred to as **Allhallowtide** and are a time for honouring the saints and praying for all recently departed souls.

The term **hallow** means “holy” – you may recall reciting it in the Lord’s Prayer, “Our Father who art in heaven, **hallowed** be thy name” (Mt 6:9).
