

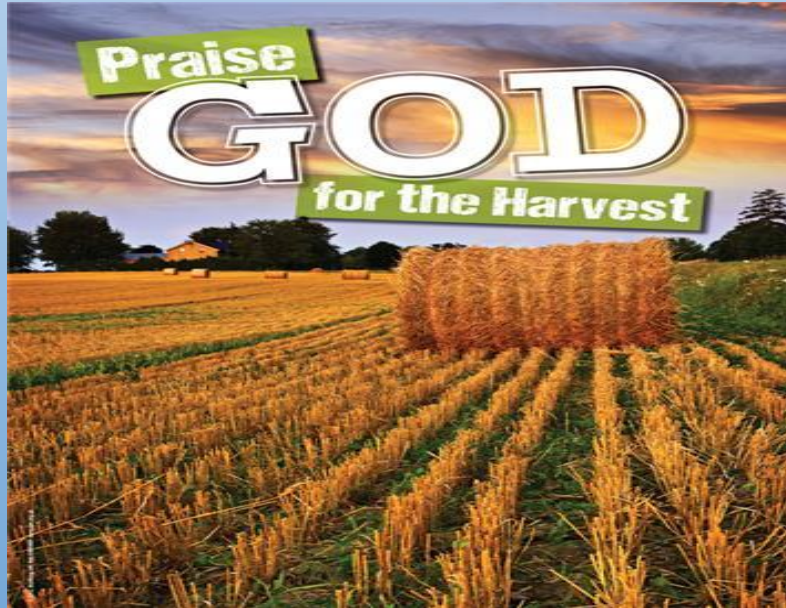

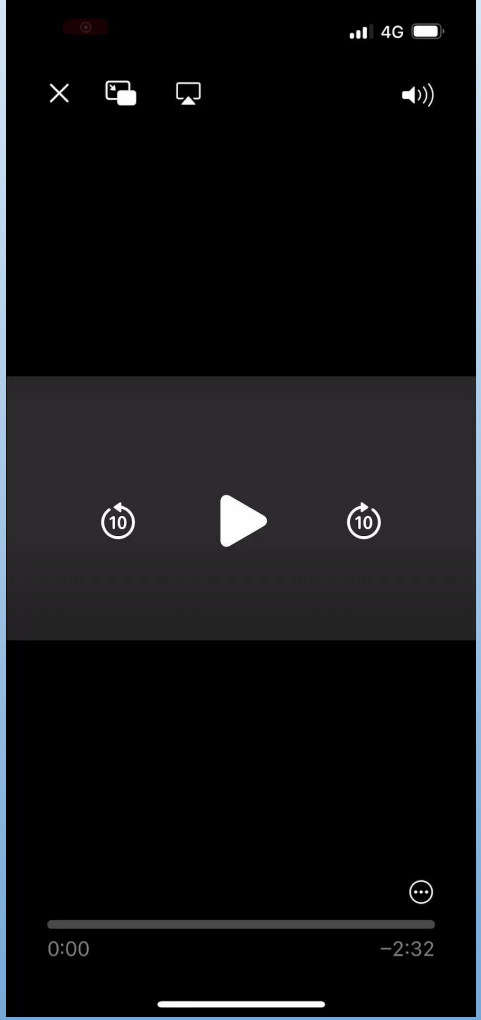

Thank you for the farmers who work so hard all year round to make sure we have food to eat.

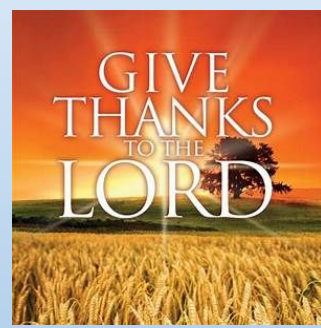
Thank you for all the people who work in factories and shops who make sure there is food to buy.
