
















"I have a dream that my four children will one day live in a nation where they will not be judged by the color of their skin, but by the content of their character."

  - Could you try to make peace with someone whom you disagreed with, without getting angry or even violent?








## Reflection Do you try to treat everyone fairly?

So everyone knows they belong and no one feels alone (hug hands together)


## **AMEN**
