SPRING 1 OVERVIEW: SINGING

Year Group	What will be covered?	Learning Outcomes
1	Pupils will learn the importance of warming up and cooling down before and after singing. They will learn how to breathe within a song without 'snatching' breath and how posture can help with our breath. Pupils will also learn the keyword diction and see how useful it is, they will also investigate when it's used and when it's dropped and the reasons behind this. 3	Pupils in Key Stage 2 will learn a number of keywords that will help them control their voice, their pitch and their breathing. Whereas in lower levels pupils have been taught the keywords and how they affect your singing, Key Stage 2 pupils will be taught how the keywords link together to help with the overall sound and precision of singing. Pupils will learn about different techniques that songs use to keep them interesting such as verses, choruses and call and response.
