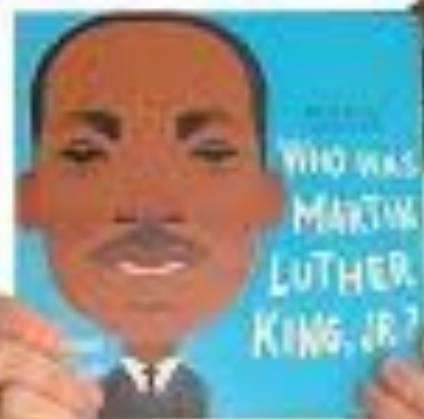
Learning about life in all its fullness

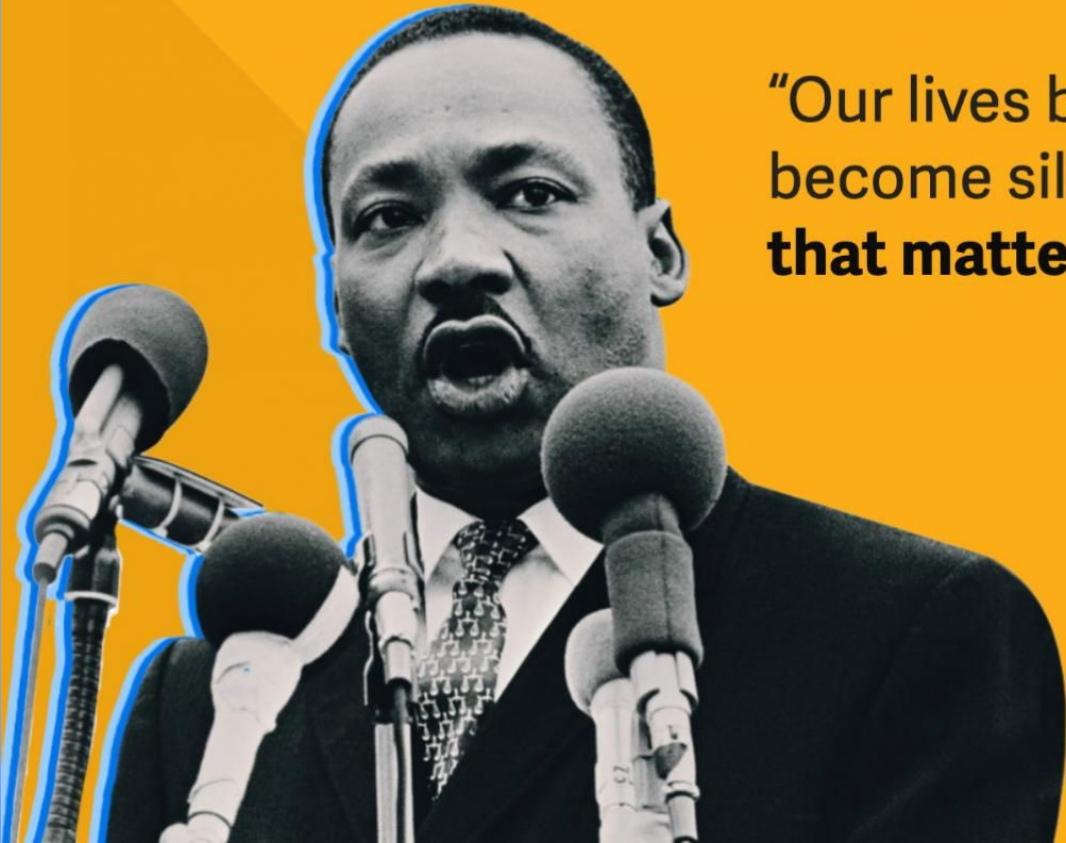

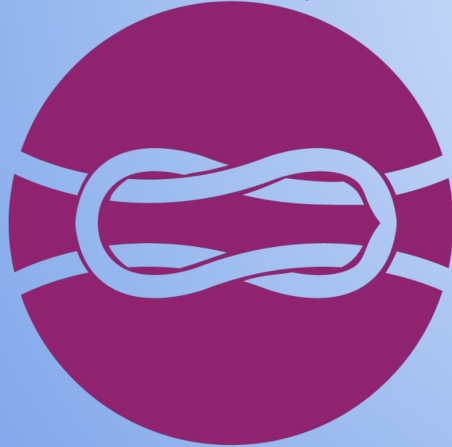

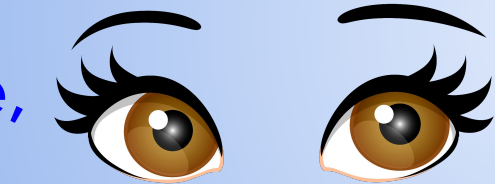
