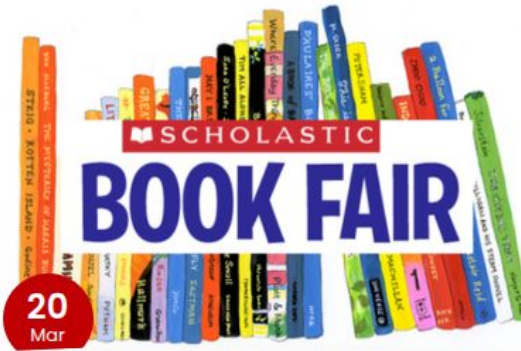
### Let's go sing concert!

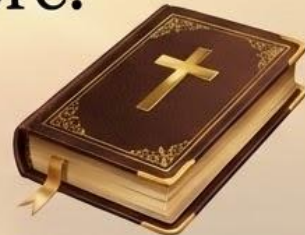
