Amen.





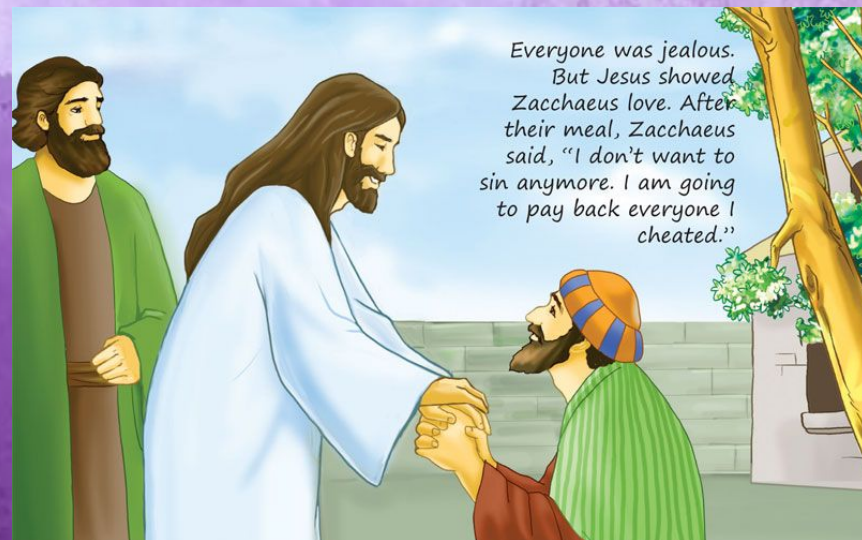
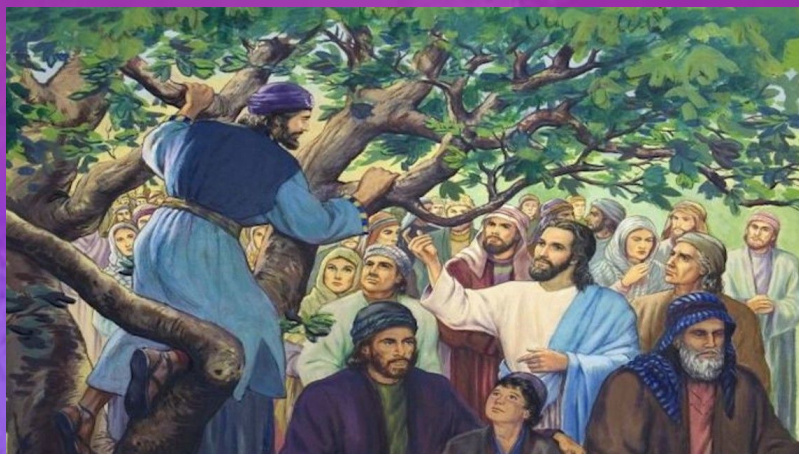
Bible verses: The Bible clearly states that Christians should forgive others because they have been forgiven by God.

For if you forgive other people when they sin against you, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. Matthew 6:14





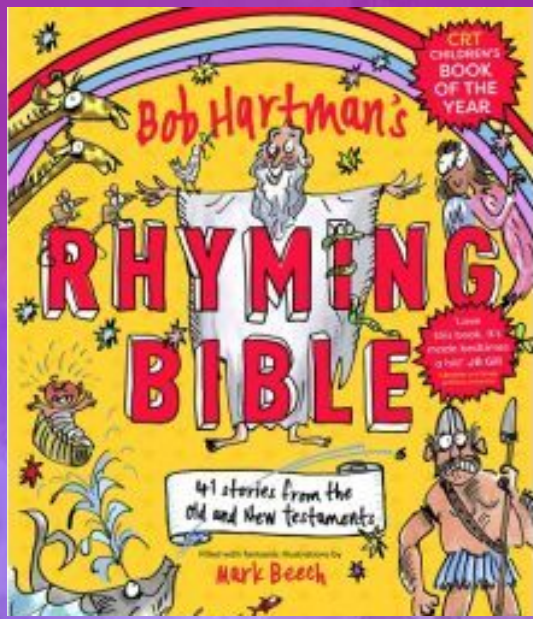
