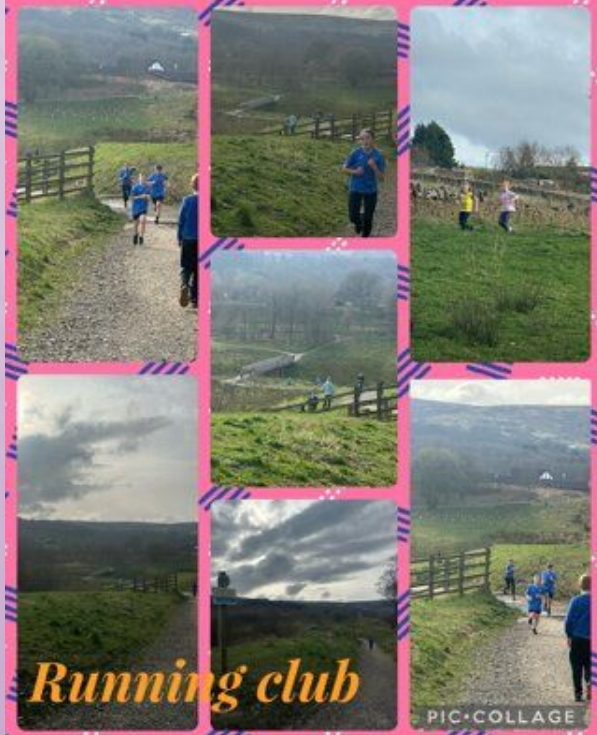

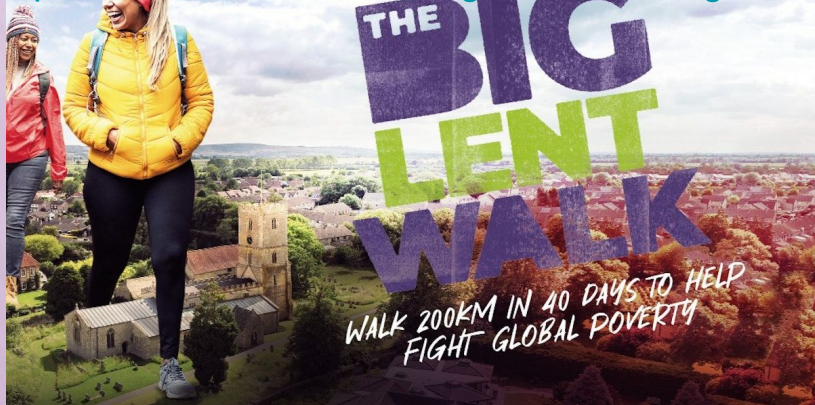

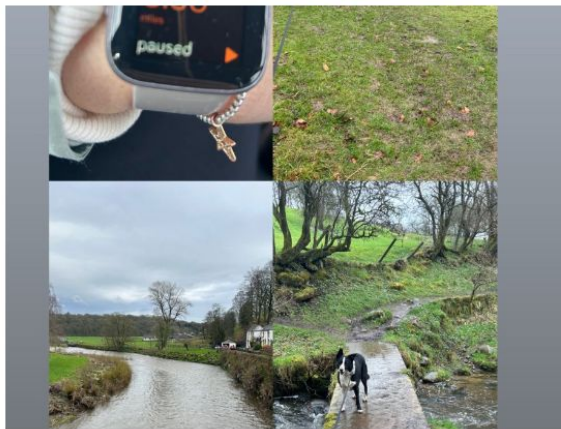

Miss Baxendale enjoyed an 8km walk around Whalley Nab.



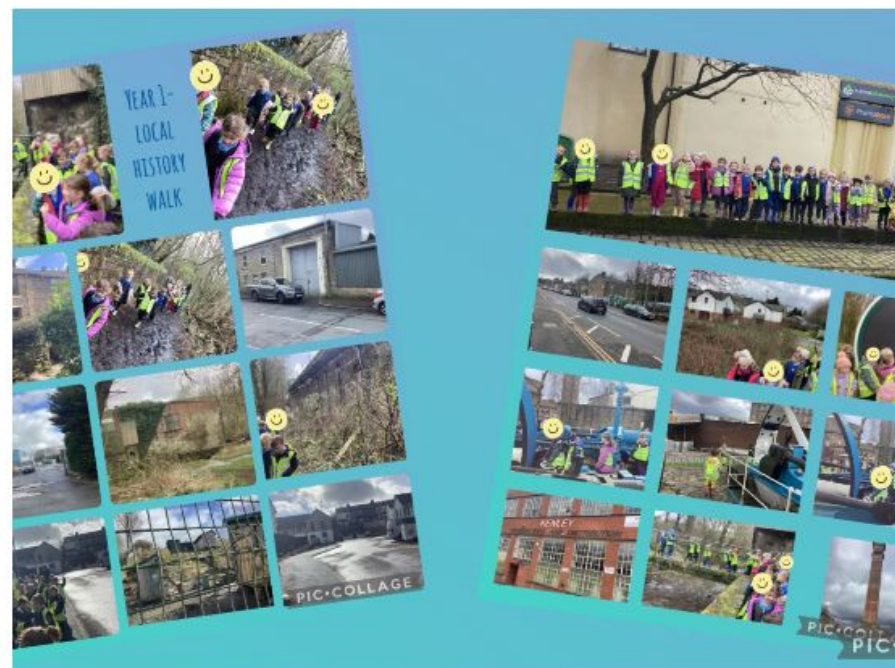
Mrs Ham walked 5.03km with Mrs Price and their dogs around Sunnyhurst Woods.

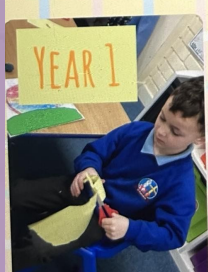

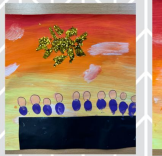

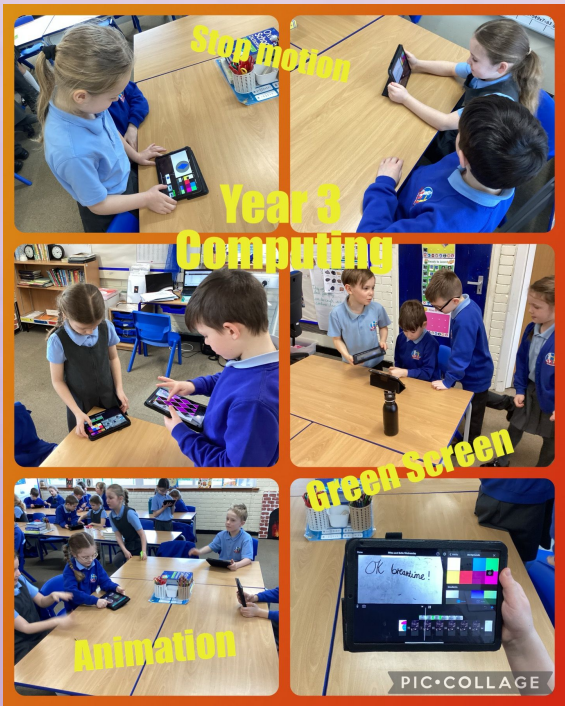
