Headteacher's Message

Dear Parents and Carers, what a busy few weeks we have had in school and we have a couple of exciting weeks ahead during Advent. This excitement sometimes leads to silliness and this week we have had to remind our children in Worship about our value of respect. Recently we haven't always seen respect being shown as much at break and lunch times, whereas when in class, the children behave brilliantly. We are working as a staff team to promote respect to everyone and we hope you will support us in this.

Please may I politely remind you that our official start time in the morning is **8.55am**. This is the time that children need to be in class with their coat and bag off and ready for the register, not the time that they are arriving at the bottom gate. We have several children in school arriving after this time so they are missing out on our morning learning activities and are often missing ordering their lunch on time too. Being late for school or missing days really does have a negative impact on children's learning as the following table demonstrates.
