Attendance

A huge well done to all of our classes for amazing attendance so far this year. The Government attendance target is 95% but our school and Trust target is 96%. For this half term our whole school attendance is 96.98%. This is wonderful considering the bugs that have been around school over the last few weeks. Let's keep this up all year! We will be awarding 'Amazing Attendance' certificates to children with over 96% attendance at the end of each term.

Please may I politely remind you that our official start time in the morning is **8.55am**. This is the time that children need to be in class with their coat and bag off and ready for the register, not the time that they are arriving at the bottom gate. We have some children in school arriving after this time so they are missing out on our morning learning activities and are often missing ordering their lunch on time too. We open the classroom doors at **8.45am** so there is plenty of time to get into class and get ready. Being late for school or missing days really does have a negative impact on children's learning as the following table demonstrates.
