How did the Anglo-Saxons take control of England?

After Alfred, Anglo-Saxon kings from the Danelaw territories back from the Vikings. Alfred's grandson, **Aethelstan**, is called England's first king as he is the first king to rule over the whole of England.

In AD927, the Anglo-Saxons drove out **Ella**, the last Viking king of Northumbria. Later, when Ella was killed in battle, the Vikings agreed to be ruled by England's king.

The first general Anglo-Saxon king was **Edward**. Welsh and Scottish lands were taken over by the English, and his court at **Winchester** was one of the most important in Europe.

Anglo-Saxon England remained to peak during Edward's reign.
