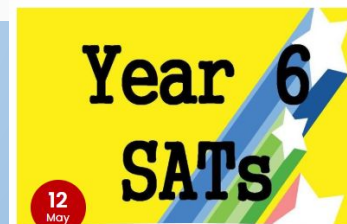
VE Day 80th Anniversary- Red, white and blue day
