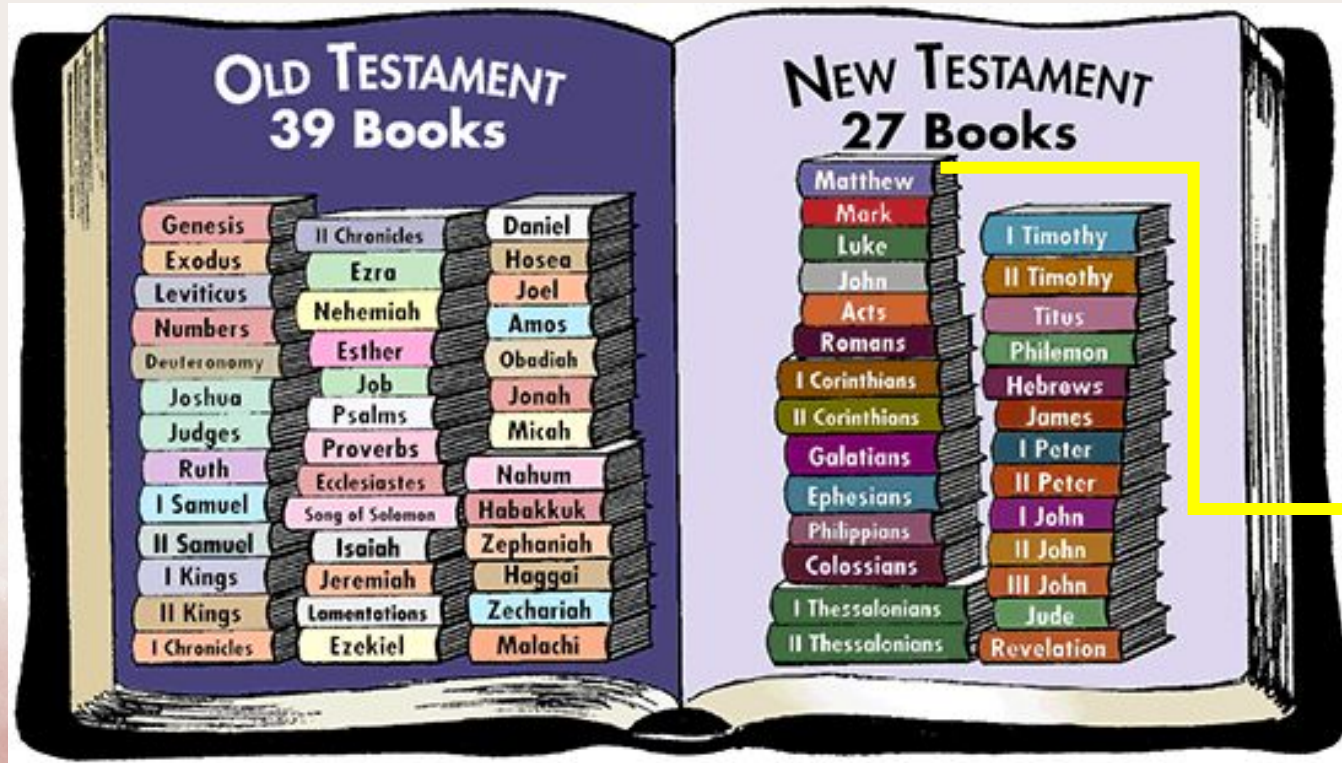
Engage

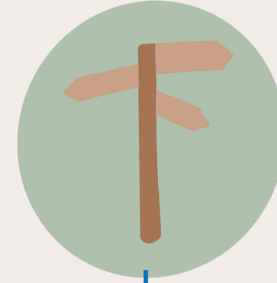
