A vocal stem is the isolated singing of a song. It means that we can listen to the artist singing with no music in background.

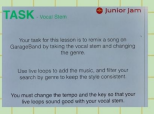

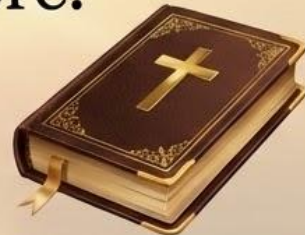

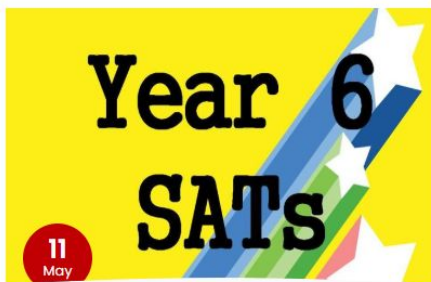
