So he went and lay down.⁶ Again the LORD called, "Samuel!" And Samuel got up and went to Eli and said, "Here I am; you called me."My son," Eli said, "I did not call; go back and lie down."⁷ Now Samuel did not yet know the LORD: The word of the LORD had not yet been revealed to him.⁸ A third time the LORD called, "Samuel!" And Samuel got up and went to Eli and said, "Here I am; you called me."Then Eli realized that the LORD was calling the boy. ⁹So Eli told Samuel, "Go and lie down, and if he calls you, say, 'Speak, LORD, for your servant is listening.'" So Samuel went and lay down in his place.¹⁰ The LORD came and stood there, calling as at the other times, "Samuel! Then Samuel! with samuel said, "Speak, for your servant is listenina."
