Mark 3:20-35 **Jesus Accused by His Family and by Teachers of the Law**²⁰ Then Jesus entered a house, and again a crowd gathered, so that he and his disciples were not even able to eat. ²¹ When his family^[2] heard about this, they went to take charge of him, for they said, "He is out of his mind."²² And the teachers of the law who came down from Jerusalem said, "He is possessed by Beelzebul! By the prince of demons he is driving out demons."²³ So Jesus called them over to him and began to speak to them in parables: "How can Satan drive out Satan? ²⁴ If a kingdom is divided against itself, that kingdom cannot stand. ²⁵ If a house is divided against itself, that house cannot stand. ²⁴ And if Satan opposes himself and is divided, he cannot stand; his end has come. ²⁷ In fact, no one can enter a strong man's house without first tying him up. Then he can plunder the strong man's house. ²⁸ Truly I tell you, people can be forgiven all their sins and every slander they utter, ²⁹ but whoever blasphemes against the Holy Spirit will never be forgiven; they are guilty of an eternal sin."³⁰ He said this because they were saying, "He has an impure spirit."³¹ Then Jesus' mother and brothers are outside looking for you."³³ "Who are my mother and my brothers?" he asked.³⁴ Then he looked at those seated in a circle around him and said, "Here are my mother and my brothers? ³⁵ Whoever does God's will is my brother and sister and mother."
