Early Learning Goals: People Culture and Communities

Children at the expected level of development will:

- Describe their immediate environment using knowledge from observation, discussion, stories, non-fiction texts and maps;
- Know some similarities and differences between different religious and cultural communities in this country, drawing on their experiences and what has been read in class;
- Explain some similarities and differences between life in this country and life in other countries, drawing on knowledge from stories, non-fiction texts and when appropriate maps.

Class Teachers Subject leaders will use the guidance from the Department for Education 's Development Matters Document 2021 to determine progression and children's corresponding attainment. (See pages 99 onwards for full details)
