YEAR 2

YEAR 3

It has been a very positive and uplifting week

YEAR 4

This week we have been looking at Friendships. We have discussed lots of ways we can be friends, how to resolve conflict and how to work as a team. This required perseverance, friendship, teamwork and trust.

YEAR 5

YEAR 6

We took part in a documentary challenge where we had to choose our favourite exhibit, learn about it and then film a short documentary, which we watched back in class. We would like to say a huge Thank You to Mr Balderson and his team from the Veterans Living History Museum, who came in to do a talk and brought various artefacts dating back to the First World War. It was a great way to complete our topic and the children loved it. We also discussed how important friendships are and touched on how to resolve issues when they arise. We all made friendship bracelets in class too, all the children really enjoyed making these.
