Agenda / Matters Discussed:	 Current action plan discussed, including progression of skills across year groups. Curriculum displays have been updated, including a range of children's work. In school art Christmas card competition. Year 6 art gallery has been set up. Local art competitions discussed. Art and craft clubs discussed, including their key successes. How art can be used a tool to promote positive mental health – including current initiatives in school such as art therapy. Using ICT within art – ICT technician to look for any apps or software to promote animation. Cross curricular links with art. Samples of work and photo evidence explored. Relevant courses discussed that the team are going on, including 'progression in art'.
