## **Home Learning Plans – September 2020**

During this difficult time, our primary aim is to ensure the safety and wellbeing of our staff, pupils and families. We understand a school or class closure is inconvenient and will impact families in different way. Within this in mind, we do our best to ensure school remains open where possible. However, we understand there may be times that some children cannot be in school for a period of time. This document demonstrates what would happen in different circumstances on an individual and class basis. Please familiarise yourself with the information below in order to best support your child if we had to close for any reason.

### Children unable to come to school due to:

- Waiting for test results for themselves or somebody in their household.
- 1. Signpost families to online resources Oxford Owl eBooks, Times Table Rockstars app, BBC Bitesize resources, Oak National Academy, White Rose Maths.
- 2. CGP books passed to individuals isolating after October half term to subsidise online resources whilst isolating for a short time.

#### Children unable to come to school due to:

- Bubble closed for 14 days following a positive test result.
- Being advised to isolate by NHS Track and Trace.
- Quarantining after returning from abroad.
- Unable to come to schools due to a sibling being in a closed bubble.
- 1. Children are to receive a 2 week work pack. This will be 'stand alone' but will link to the topics covered within school.
- 2. Signpost families to online resources Oxford Owl eBooks, Times Table Rockstars app, BBC Bitesize resources, Oak National Academy, White Rose Maths.

# Children unable to come to school due to:

- Leeds schools closed due to local lockdown restrictions.
- Being advised not to come to school due to being clinically extremely vulnerable.
- 1. Online learning will be posted on the school website. Children will be able to email in examples of their work for teachers to provide feedback. Staff in school will make regular contact with children and families to complete welfare checks and support as required.
- 2. Children will be offered an optional paper pack if they don't have access to the internet.
- 3. Signpost families to online resources Oxford Owl eBooks, Times Table Rockstars app, BBC Bitesize resources, Oak National Academy, White Rose Maths.

# Children unable to come to school due to:

- Illness COVID related or otherwise.
- 1. No work will be sent whilst the children are too unwell to complete it. Parents are to contact school if the child makes a recovery and need work within an isolation period.

# All home learning materials will be:

- Accessible for all pupils, with differentiation as appropriate.
- Able to be completed with minimal resources or with resources provided.
- Purposeful to improving academic outcomes rather than 'holding activities'.
- Able to be returned to school for marking and feedback if requested by parents/carer
- Broad and balanced in relation to curricular subject coverage.
