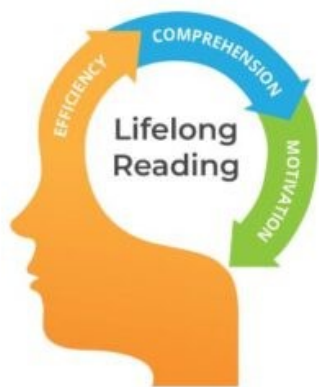

Children in Years 5 and 6 are encouraged to access Reading Plus at home. 'Reading Plus is an online resource.' This means your child has free access to this resource.

What is Reading Plus?

Reading Plus is an online reading development program. It works by building upon the foundational skills of phonics and phonemic awareness to develop a child's silent reading fluency, vocabulary and deeper understanding.



Reading Plus develops reading efficiency in order to free up mental energy for comprehension, and make reading more enjoyable and rewarding.

The program is for children who no longer need support in phonics.

However, there will be tasks set on Reading Plus that those children can complete.

What will children be expected to do at home?

Children will be encouraged to access Reading Plus at home to help develop their fluency and comprehension skills.

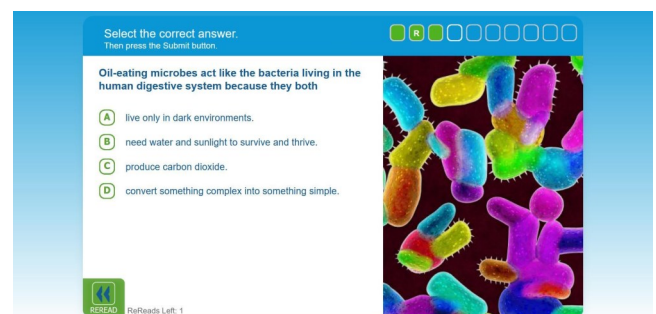
Teachers will monitor daily usage of Reading Plus so they will be able to monitor which children access it at home.

Homework Club

There is a homework club every Monday and Thursday lunchtimes for children in Years 5 and 6 - children who want to access Reading Plus outside of curriculum time can also attend homework club.

What does Reading Plus involve?

A child has five reading assignments per week and one vocabulary assignment per week. Once children have completed their assigned lessons for the week the entire program unlocks and they continue to do as much as they want of any lesson, it does not limit reading!



How to get access to Reading Plus at home?

- Step 1: Go to login.readingplus.com
- Step 2: Press the Student Login button
- Step 3: Enter Site Code: rpstbartho
- Step 4: Type Username
- Step 5: Type Password
