




Children in Years 5 and 6 will be expected to complete some of their homework on Reading Plus. 'Reading Plus is an online resource.' This means your child has free access to this resource.

What is Reading Plus?

Reading Plus is an online reading development program. It works by building upon the foundational skills of phonics and phonemic awareness to develop a child's silent reading fluency, vocabulary and deeper understanding.



The program is for children who no longer need support in phonics.

However, there will be tasks set on Reading Plus that those children can complete.

What will children be expected to do at home?

Children will be expected to complete at least 30 minutes of Reading Plus at home.

Teachers will monitor daily usage of Reading Plus so they will be able to monitor which children complete Reading Plus for homework. If your child wants to complete more at home – amazing!

Children who do not complete their homework will be expected to attend homework club on a Monday.

Phone calls home will be made to families of children who persistently do not do homework.

There is a homework club every Monday and Thursday lunchtime.



What does Reading Plus involve?

A child has five reading assignments per week and one vocabulary assignment per week. Once children have completed their assigned lessons for the week the entire program unlocks and they continue to do as much as they want of any lesson, it does not limit reading!



How to get access to Reading Plus at home?

Step 1: Go to login.readingplus.com

Step 2: Press the Student Login button

Step 3: Enter Site Code: rpstbartho

Step 4: Type Username

Step 5: Type Password
