A clear policy sets clear expectations for children and parents. Our policy is simple and enables parents to provide what their children need easily and as cheaply as possible.

The Uniform

We do not have a logo on our uniform so parents can purchase it from many shops, including supermarkets as they are more reasonably priced.

What children can wear

Children can wear black or grey school trousers or skirt. In summer red and white school dresses can be worn.

Children can wear a red or white polo shirt.

Red cardigans, red jumpers or plain red hoodies are allowed.

We allow black school shoes or black trainers.

P.E

We ask that children come to school in their PE kit on the days they have PE. This reduces the time spent in school getting changed and enables the children to have longer doing PE and physical activity.

This should be black or grey tracksuit, jogging bottoms, shorts or leggings and a red plain t-shirt. Each child will receive one from school. This must only be worn on PE days.

Black or white trainers can be worn.

They should bring a suitable top, black or red hoodie or black or red tracksuit top for if it is colder outside.

Support

We do have a small stock of good quality second hand uniform which we can donate to children if we have their size available.

If you do have old uniform that your child has grown out of please donate it to school and we can make good use of it. This includes PE kit.

Children grow quickly and this helps other families and is a good way to recycle.
