St Bart's Quick Guide To: Years 5 and 6



A warm welcome to Years 5 and 6! This guide outlines some important information that you will need to help your child stay organised and to have a successful time in Upper Key Stage 2.

Our curriculum

In Years 5 & 6 we will be covering the following topics:

Autumn - Activism/Rivers Spring - Vikings/Climate

Summer — Ancient Greece/National Parks

Across all curriculum areas, we make meaningful links to these topics where appropriate. For more information, please see our Year **Group Overviews** on the school website. Here, you'll also find details about what your what your child will be learning in **English** and Maths.



Homework Expectations

Children are expected to read their reading book at home every night.

Each week, children will be expected to complete homework on **Emile** (with tasks set in Grammar, Punctuation and Maths) and Oxford Owl (tasks set in Spelling).

They will also be encouraged to use **Reading** Plus at home to support their reading development. Homework is given on **Monday** and must be completed by the following Monday.

There will be a **Homework Club** every **Monday** lunchtime for children in Years 5 and 6, giving them the opportunity to complete homework during the school day.

Children who complete all their homework will be rewarded with a longer lunchtime on Friday.

Each term, children will also have the opportunity to complete a variety of tasks linked to other areas of the curriculum.

Drop off and collection

Children will enter school through the Year 1 playground. Mr Needham is there on a morning to answer any questions, or pass on any information to the class teacher. Children in Years 5 and 6 will enter the school building independently and walk to their class.

Classes 12 & 13 will exit school at 15:25 and be either collected or walk home from the Year 1 playground—each class will walk to the fence.

Classes 14, 15 & 16 will also exit school at 15:25 and be either collected or walk home from the following points:

Class 14—door near the hall and library. Class 15- hall door leading on to the path between the Year 1 playground and the big playground.

Class 16-hall door leading on to the Year 1 playground.

All staff members in Years 5 and 6 will be supporting the pupils in demonstrating the following school pupil attributes:



What to remember!

Your child will need to remember to bring the following each day:

- Their reading book
- Their planner
- Any homework they have been
- Any letters needed to be passed back to school.
- Appropriate clothing (labelled) e.g. a jacket or coat dependent on the weather.

Children will be encouraged to bring their things in some form of bag (for example, book bag or rucksack).
