St Bart's Quick Guide To: Years 5 and 6



A warm welcome to Years 5 and 6! This guide outlines some important information that you will need to help your child stay organised and to have a successful time in Upper Key Stage 2.

Our curriculum

In Years 5 & 6 we will be covering the following topics:

Autumn - World War 2/Mountains Spring— Early Islamic Civilisation/Volcanoes Summer - Windrush/Fair Trade

Through each curricular area, we make links to these topics where appropriate. Please see our Year group overviews on the website for further details. Here you will also find what your child will be learning in English and Maths.





Homework

Children are expected to read their reading book at home every night. We also encourage children to use Reading Plus at home.

Each week, children will be given

Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling and Maths homework on Emile to complete. Homework is given on a Monday and needs to be completed by the following Monday.

There is a homework club every Monday and Thursday lunchtimes for children in Years 5 and 6 to have the opportunity to do homework during the school day.

Children will also have the opportunity to complete a variety of other tasks each term linked to other areas of the curriculum.

Drop off and collection

Children will enter school through the Year 1 playground. Mr Needham is there on a morning to answer any questions, or pass on any information to the class teacher. Children in Years 5 and 6 will enter the school building independently and walk to their class.

Classes 12 & 13 will exit school at 15:25 and be either collected or walk home from the Year 1 playground—each class will walk to the fence.

Classes 14, 15 & 16 will also exit school at 15:25 and be either collected or walk home from the following points:

Class 14—door near the hall and library. Class 15- hall door leading on to the path between the Year 1 playground and the big playground.

Class 16-hall door leading on to the Year 1 playground.

What to remember!

Your child will need to remember to bring the following each day:

- Their reading book
- Their planner
- Any homework they have been
- Any letters needed to be passed back to school.
- Appropriate clothing—e.g. a jacket or coat dependent on the weather.

Children will be encouraged to bring their things in some form of bag (for

example, book bag or rucksack).
