Free School Meals

All children in reception to year 2 are entitled to universal free school meals. These are provided by the government to ensure all children in those years have access to a hot, healthy school meal.

Children in years 3 to 6 and those who have a full day place in nursery may be entitled to benefits related free school meals. If you need help with this Mrs Busby in the office will be able to offer guidance.


Paid School Meals

You can pay for your child to have a paid school meal.

It is £10 per week and is to be paid on a Monday. This can be by cash which can be taken to your child's class in a labelled envelope or by card at the office.

The school subsidises the cost of paid meals to keep the cost as low as possible for you so as many children as possible can have a hot. nutritious meal.

Unless there is a special day we expect children to have school meals for a full week.



The Menus

We have a three week menu cycle which is changed half way through the year. There are always four options. All the menus can be seen on our website or you can ask to see them at the office. This will allow you to help your children chose We provide fresh drinking water for their meal if they need support.

Special Diets

If your child has a medical condition or allergies the catering team can prepare a special menu to meet their needs. Please Children in nursery eat within the just ask at the office for information on how to arrange this.

Themed Days

There are days through out the year when we offer a themed menu. On these days children who usually have packed lunches can have a meal for that one day that week. This is available to both paid and free meals and can be paid for on the children to use a knife and fork when Monday of that week. The cost is £2. This is a good opportunity for children who usually have packed lunches to try school meals.

Halal

We are now able to serve Halal to children if required. This is served on days when it is appropriate. Halal meals must be ordered by parents and children must have that choice each day it is served. If you would like further information or wish to order this for your child please complete the form for the beginning of the year or ask at the office after this. If your child has Halal and you would like to cancel this you must inform the office.

Water
