# Nursery Learning Journals

As part of the assessment in Nursery your child will have an electronic profile on Learning Journals. We would like to encourage

parents to contribute to their child's assessment at school and parents are able to upload information to their child's profile. Large floor books are developed to display our super learning and exciting activities throughout the year.

### **School Dinners**

If your child stays at school for full days there is a charge of 3 pounds per day. They will also need a packed lunch or a school dinner. School dinners cost £2.00 per day for Nursery children. You can pay for your dinners for the week every Monday. The school has a tasty and healthy menu system. Dinner menus are displayed weekly in classrooms and on the corridor for parents to view available meal choices.

### **School Uniform**

It is school policy that **all** children wear school uniform. It is available to buy at very reasonable prices. School uniform consists of a red jumper or cardigan, a white polo shirt and black or grey trousers or a skirt/ pinafore. Red checked dresses are suitable for summer. Please ensure that you put your child's name in their school uniform.

### **Lending Library**

Throughout the year we will be developing our lending library. Parents will be encouraged to enter Nursery and share a story with their child and take the book home for a few days. More information on our lending library will follow.
