




Children in Years 5 and 6 will be encouraged to use Reading Plus at home. 'Reading Plus is an online resource.' This means your child has free access to this resource.

What is Reading Plus?

Reading Plus is an online reading development program. It works by building upon the foundational skills of phonics and phonemic awareness to develop a child's silent reading fluency, vocabulary and deeper understanding.



The program is for children who no longer need support in phonics.

However, there will be tasks set on Reading Plus that those children can complete.

What will children be expected to do at home?

Children will be encouraged to use Reading Plus at home.

Teachers will monitor daily usage of Reading Plus so they will be able to monitor which children use Reading Plus at home.

Homework Club

There will be a homework club every Monday and lunchtime for children in Years 5 and 6 to have the opportunity to do homework during the school day.
