#### <u>Uniform</u>

We expect all children to wear uniform, non of which has a logo to ensure you can purchase it from all major shops.

It consists of grey or black trousers, skirt or dress. White or red polo shirt and red jumper or cardigan. Children can wear black shoes or trainers.

Children should come in their PE kit on the days they have PE. This should be grey or black joggers, leggings or shorts and a t-shirt (provided by school). They should have trainers for PE.

#### **School Dinners**

Leeds Catering provide the school meals and they ensure they meet all the appropriate food standards. We are a nut free kitchen and can provide for different dietary requirements.

We run a 3 week menu that changes in spring. Menus are available on the website. All children in reception and years 1 and 2 are entitled to free school meals.

You may also be eligible to 'benefits related school meals' provided by the government. Please ask at the office if you need support with this.

#### **Child Protection**

We have 7 designated staff who take overall responsibility for safeguarding in school.

Miss Lawson is our Designated Safeguard Lead and Family Support Lead.

We follow all Leeds procedures and policies and keeping our children safe in and out of school is a priority.

If we have any concerns we will act quickly and will report to the relevant agencies if we need to. If you have any questions or need any support please ask.

#### **Attendance and Punctuality**

Excellent attendance is vital for children to flourish and achieve.

All children should be in school and on time unless they are too unwell to attend.

If your child is not attending school we expect parents to inform us and explain the reasons.

We do not authorise holidays in term time and will only authorise absences in exceptional circumstances, this must be applied for using the correct form in advance.

Being on time is vital. Every time your child is late for school they miss reading and the start of lessons, catching up is difficult.

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#### **Applying for a School Place**

All applications for a place in reception for September 2024 must go through Leeds City Council admissions. The deadline is 15th January 2025, if you have missed this please ask at the office and we can let you know what you would need to do.

In year admissions. If you want your child to move to our school you will need to complete a Leeds in-year transfer form. This is available on line, please ask if you need support with this.

We manage our own nursery admissions and we can advise you if we have a place available. We offer places to children after their third birthday if there is one available.

Full details of the sessions and an application form are available at the office.

#### **Religious Education and Worship**

Our lessons and daily worship are inclusive and respectful of all our children. We teach about a range of religions and beliefs with a Christian focus.

If you wish to discuss withdrawing your children from lessons or worship please arrange to see Mrs Wainwright.

#### **No Smoking Policy**

We do not allow smoking in our school or on our site.

#### **Parking**

Parking outside school is very limited due to our location. We ask that where possible you walk to school with your children. If you do drive please do not park on the zig-zag lines or the curbs. Please also be considerate of the local residents who need access to their properties at all times.

We would also ask that you turn off your engine whilst waiting, this protects the environment and is better for people walking by.

#### **Special Educational Needs**

We welcome all children and will support children who have additional needs as much as we can. We have three Special Educational Needs Co-coordinators and a team of staff with a wealth of experience and knowledge. We work closely with outside agencies to ensure our children's needs are identified and met.

### Breakfast Club, After School Club and Play Scheme

Our school managed provisions are very popular and unfortunately due to staffing and health and safety regulations we are not always able to meet everyone's needs. We try to provide enough places and ask you only use these provisions if you need childcare. If we cannot meet your needs we will add you to a waiting list.

The school subsidises these provisions in order to keep the cost as low as possible for you but we do insist payments are made in advance.

Late payments will result in your place being withdrawn.

#### **Complaints**

We hope that your children are very happy at school and you do not have any problems or concerns. However we know that sometimes things can go wrong or you may have a concern or complaint. We ask that you come and see us about this as we want to deal with any issues as soon as possible and often a conversation at an early stage often prevents problems growing.
