St Bart's Quick Guide To: Years 3 and 4



Welcome!

Welcome to Years 3 and 4 and the start of your journey in Key Stage 2! At this age, we always notice children start to grow up and we enjoy seeing them becoming more independent. This guide outlines some important information that you will need to help your child stay organized and be successful in Years 3 and 4.

Our curriculum

Please see our school website for the things your child will be learning in Years 3 and 4.

Y3 topics: Anglo Saxons, Romans, Tudors, Megacities, Earthquakes, Sustainability. Y4 topics: Victorians, Stone Age, Ancient Egypt, Local area, Deserts and jungles, USA.

Through each curricular area, we make links to these topics where appropriate. If you have any questions regarding the curriculum, please see Mr Waters or your child's class teacher.

What to remember!

Your child will need to remember to bring the following each day:

- Their reading book / Library book
- Any letters needed to be passed back to school.
- Appropriate clothing—e.g. a jacket or coat dependent on the weather.
- PE kit on PE days

Drop off and collection

Children are dropped off at the side of the Nursery playground. Mr Waters is there on a morning to answer any questions or pass on any information to the class teacher. We expect children in Years 3 and 4 to walk upstairs independently.

The children will be collected at 3:20 at the following points: Class 7 and 8 - Nursery playground

Classes 9, 10 and 11—Train playground.

We ask for parents to go round to the fence when collecting classes 9, 10 and 11.

Homework

This year, we are using technology to complete homework. Children are expected to complete 15 minutes on Times table rockstars, and complete their spelling task on Oxford Owl. Most families have a device this can be done on. If you have any problems with this, please see Mr Waters. Children who are in a phonics group will receive a paper homework sheet.

Children are also expected to read their reading book at home every night.

We will also be continuing to send out homework linked to other areas of the curriculum, in response to feedback from parents.

Homework is set on a Monday and needs completing by Friday.

Login details will be provided within the first few weeks of term.

If children do not complete tasks by a Friday, they must complete it during their break time.

PE

Each class has 2 PE slots per week. Children can come dressed in their PE kits on these days. Children will be given a red t-shirt to wear on these days.

Class 9— Monday and Wednesday

Class 10— Tuesday and Thursday

Class 11—Thursday and Friday





















