Farrow Bank- Tong Road Passing Priory View medical Centre, Thorton Medical Centre up to Burmantofts Cemetery 5 min walk down (500 yards) Stony Rock Lane to St James hospital.

Bus 15

Heights Drive Heights Bank- Armley Town Street -Passing Armley Moor Medical Centre, Priory View medical Centre, Thorton Medical Centre, the Headrow - near Leeds General Infirmary.

Bus 16

Popular Rise - Armley Town Street -Passing Armley Moor Medical Centre, Priory View medical Centre, Thorton Medical Centre up to St James Hospital.

Bus 72

Stanningly Road up to The Headrow (walking distance from Leeds General Infirmary).

Bus 42

Lower Wortley road, pass Copley hill (walking distant to priory View and Thornton Medical) to the Headrow near Leeds General Infirmary.

Bus 3, 3A

From Corn exchange to Chapel Allerton Hospital.

Bus 36

From leeds city centre bus station to Chapel Allerton Hospital.

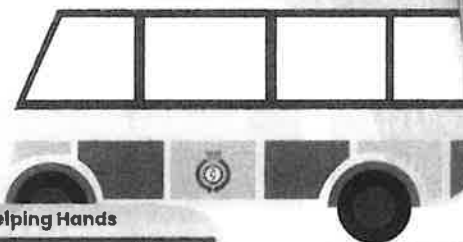
