Nursery really enjoyed looking after 5 eggs, which turned into beautiful chicks. We watched them grow before they went off to live on the farm!

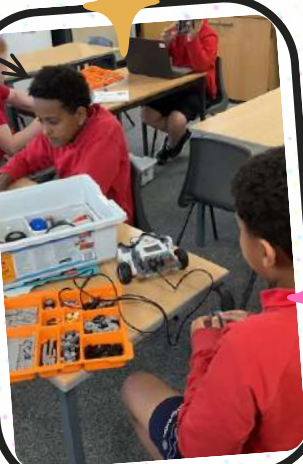


TOUR OF HEADINGLEY
