


Historians use sources as clues to the past so we can better understand how life was like, or why events happened.

Historians find out the reasons why events happened and what happened as a result.

Historians analyse sources and evidence to decide reasons why events occurred, and to understand the consequences after, and its impact on people. We are working as a historian by observing: Significance and Impact



Historians assess people, events and civilisations using sources and knowledge to decide if what their impact on history was. They also summise and evaluate if their impact was significant and important.
