Remote Learning

The staff have worked extremely hard to provide remote learning for children who have to stay at home. This includes live sessions, videos and online work or work packs. If you require any support with this please contact school and we will do our best to help you and your children.

We have had many requests for support with laptops and are trying our best to allocate them as fairly as possible. We have been focussing this support on KS2 as the guidance recommends and are now moving to KS1. As we receive more devices, we will be able to support as many children as possible.

The next work packs will be available for collections from Friday 22nd January. These will be for three weeks to last until half term.

Someone from school will contact you at least once a week to check how home learning is going and to offer any support.

Positive Tests
