Dear Parent/Carer

We are very pleased to announce that Class 13 will be swimming every Friday. The first lesson will be on Friday 15th September. Children will walk to the leisure centre unless the weather is deemed to be unacceptable (the school minibuses will be used if needed – providing they are available). The class will return to school by 3:30pm and your child can be collected from the usual collection point.

Leisure Centre staff will teach the swimming lessons alongside school staff.

Children will be expected to wear still wear school uniform and to get changed into their swim wear at the leisure centre. Swimwear for boys can be shorts but must not go past the knee and for girls a one piece swim costume. Long hair must be tied back, a swim cap may be worn if preferred (especially in the winter months).

Children must not wear jewellery on swimming days. They must have a towel and a bag (it can be a plastic bag) to keep towel/clothing in

The leisure centre will provide armbands for those children who require them.

Ahead of the first lesson all children and staff members will watch a walkthrough video of what to expect when they arrive for their swimming lesson. Part of this video, the drowning and fire alarms will be sounded, and information on what to do upon hearing either of them.

Attending school swimming lessons ensures that children and young people have the opportunity to swim safely and proficiently.

Only children with a doctor's note will be excused from swimming.

Please complete the attached pupil ability sheet which will allow us to provide information to the centre ahead of the first lessons.
