

HOT WEATHER ACTIONS



As you are all aware the weather is unusually hot and this is forecast for the foreseeable future.

In school we are:

- Limiting the time children spend outside, this includes cancelling full sports afternoons and PE lessons if necessary
- Providing access to water all day including outside if needed
- Providing sun cream for children who need it
- Opening windows, using the air conditioning and fans where available
- Using the cooler rooms in school where possible, this may mean children moving out of their normal rooms.

We ask that you:

- Put sun cream on your children before they come to school (it is an important protector against skin cancer for everyone) Minimum factor 15 with a UVA protection
- Ensure children wear appropriate clothes including t-shirts that cover their shoulders – NOT vest tops. Shorts that are suitable for school are acceptable.
- Send your children with a sun hat to protect their head, neck and eyes and sunglasses are an option.(please put their name in their hat)

We still expect all children to be in school every day up to the end of term.

We thank you for your support with this as we want to keep our children safe and help them have a good end to the year.
