School Places

We are now nearly up to capacity for the children we can currently accommodate. If your child is in an eligible year group or you are a key worker you **must** call school to request a place. There may be a waiting list. Please do not just turn up at school; we may not have a place.

Remember if your child or anyone in your house develops symptoms of COVID19 they must stay away from school and must be tested, using the track and trace system. School can help you with this if needed. You must inform school if anyone in your household has symptoms.

<u>September</u>

This would of course be our preferred option and once the government make a final decision we will share our plans with you, as there will probably be additional safety measures schools need to take.

From September there will continue to be limited places in our After School Club and further details of what we will be able to provide will be sent out before the end of term.

We will continue to share work on the website until the end of term.

If you would like the final work pack, for the last three weeks of term it will be available from Monday the 29th June. Please call school to order this and we will arrange a time for you to collect it.

Summer Holiday

The last day for children is Friday the 17th July. We will hopefully be re-opening to all children on Monday the 7th September.

Reports

We will give out reports on Thursday 2nd July to the children in school and those who come to pick up weekly food parcels.

On Friday 3rd July, we will be open for you to collect your child's report from 9.30-2.30pm. Please come to the main office.

There will be instructions with the reports to explain what to do if you want to speak to a teacher about your child's report.
